Monday: Nature Hike



Walk through a 3/4 mile boardwalk trail while discovering stories and traditions about the landscape. Listen to or observe wildlife that calls the Northwoods their home! Binoculars will be provided.

Tuesday: Mystery Trees



Maple or pine? Distinguish the differences between deciduous and coniferous trees using various physical characteristics. Leaf hunt relays will test your knowledge on tree identification. Examine tree growth by looking at tree cookies and counting whorls!

Wednesday: Which Way's North?



Get a sense of direction by becoming familiar with orienteering. Estimate your number of paces while navigating with a compass. Take a part in a scavenger hunt outdoors!

Thursday: Magnificent Mammals



Learn about some of the most magnificent mammals in our own backyard. Determine habitat needs and food resources that these mammals require to live. An exciting craft activity will follow for youth.

Friday: Dynamic Ducks



Ever wonder where those ducks are flying to? Migration routes are revealed and habitat areas are uncovered! Listen to the calls of waterfowl while examining mounts. Flock your crowd this route for a migration game as a follow up activity!
